

## **ATTACHMENT E**

### **Customer Checklist for Utility Interconnection**

- Submit an application to the Utility
  - ✓ Interconnection inverter must be UL 1741 listed
  - ✓ An electrical schematic drawing must be included
  - ✓ Include provisions for a lockable visible disconnect if required by the Utility or local jurisdiction

- Send application and schematic to:

Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County

Okanogan, WA 98840  
ATTN: Chief Engineer

- Receive written design approval from the Utility
- Get an electrical permit from Washington State L&I. Follow the National Electric Code (NEC) as required
- Complete the installation

Get inspections from a state electrical inspector and the Utility. Call the Utility at the numbers listed below.

- If net metered, Utility approves, or installs bi-directional meter
- If production metered, applicant purchases and installs, and Utility approves, production meter
- Submit Certificate of Completion to Utility
- Start generating power
